As Editor-in-Chief I would like to express my sincere thanks to all members of the EACR for their continued interest in the *European Journal of Cancer*. Surprisingly, there are more and more journals introduced every year relevant to cancer research and the literature is ever more complex, particularly for young research workers. The mission of the *EJC* is to remain a multidisciplinary journal, and in an age when so much exciting experimental research is being translated into issues of direct relevance to patients we believe that there is a continuing role for such a multidisciplinary approach. Our impact factor has continued to rise year on year and now stands at 4.454. We are particularly pleased that when we audit the most frequently downloaded articles we find an excellent balance between experimental, translational and clinical research.

In comparison to many competitor journals we achieve very rapid publication times and are pleased with our reputation of informing authors as soon as possible following the submission of manuscripts. Unfortunately, we are only able to accept approximately 20% of all submitted material, but we hope that this enhances the reputation of authors whose papers are successfully published in the *EJC*. We are of course indexed in Pubmed and we have a very wide readership, again reflecting the multidisciplinary nature of the journal. It is in the nature of laboratory based research that many highly specialist journals appear attractive to authors in the field, but we hope that we can continue to attract first-class manuscripts from the experimental community that will be read and appreciated by the widest possible audience.
